The graduating class of summer 2004 requested this tour as further experience of their Sacred Architecture course taught by Brian Gray. There are a few openings for others who would like to join us.



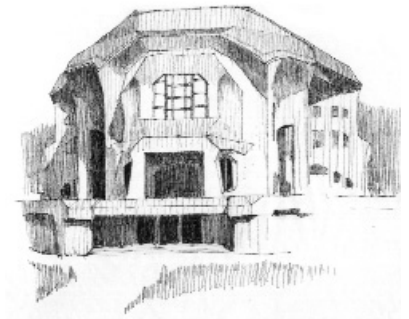
The tour begins in England, with Avebury Stone Circle and a private viewing of Stonehenge. Then to Athens, to visit the Acropolis and the National Archeological Museum to see the Grecian treasures there for safekeeping. Rome offers us the Pantheon, Santa Costanza, St Peter's Basilica and the Vatican; Florence, the Duomo and San Lorenzo. On to Barcelona to view Gaudi's fascinating structures and then to Paris to visit La Sainte Chappelle, Notre Dame Cathedral and Chartres Cathedral. We end the tour in Switzerland, in a spectacular, hidden alpine village, and a visit to the Goetheanum.



We will travel overnight whenever possible, with sleeping berths on boat and trains. Other accommodation will be hotels, monasteries & B&Bs with 2 nights in each location.

This is an active family tour in a group of 25, including Brian, Marianne, their two children, Rose and Devon, and Sarnia. Children aged 10 and over are welcome with an accompanying adult; a high school graduate can join us independently.

Estimated cost for an adult would be \$2,900, for a child under 14, \$2,300. This includes transport within Europe, accommodation and many breakfasts, guides and entrance fees as needed. It does NOT include airfare to and from Europe nor travel insurance.
