Welcome to Kenya! And you would truly be welcomed. Kenyans are the friendliest people imaginable. The land is ancient. There are places you can look over the landscape and feel no human being has ever set foot there. The Rift Valley runs through it north to south with the equator across the middle of the country, east to west. The people have learned over millennia how to make the best use of the land and have gone on to build the huge city of Nairobi while the farmers of the old ways still live in poverty with a very basic life.

We'll visit the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage and watch baby elephants being fed and rolling in the mud. Later, we can get 'up close and personal' with giraffes. The viewing platforms are high, so the giraffes' heads are on a level with ours. The right food is available so we can feed them, see their amazing long tongues and get as close, or not, as you choose.

As we visit several National Parks and Conservancies, the animals we only see in zoos anywhere else in the world are here roaming free – a moving sight. Can you imagine sitting in a safari vehicle as an old bull elephant approaches and stops within 3 feet of your car? He's not disturbed by your presence and studies you before moving aside and passing by on his way.

We'll have other encounters – though not usually quite so close! Animals in the parks and conservancies are habituated to vehicles and people inside them. They are not disturbed by our presence so long as we are quiet.
