Travel Medical Insurance is mandatory for all participants. You must declare any pre-existing medical conditions to your insurers and ensure you receive written confirmation that any pre-existing medical conditions are fully insured. You are required to have emergency medical evacuation plus medical expenses.

Medical Insurance Documentation – A copy of your insurance policy detailing policy validity dates, cover and names of those insured, must be carried on safari and shown to the safari leader at the start of the safari.

Passports – You are required to have at least 6 months validity in your passport (from the time of returning home) to enter Kenya.

Visas – are NOT required but now an eTA must be applied for online at etakenya.go.ke. (See Useful Information, to come.)

Health, fitness and ability – It is imperative for everyone's sake that you are reasonably fit and healthy enough to be able to participate in the safari. Vaccinations & anti-malarial protocol are optional. Enquire at your local travel clinic.

Names – Airlines now require first and surnames in order to issue flight tickets and may refuse boarding to any that do not exactly match up with the relevant passport. Please ensure that all names provided are complete and correct (no nicknames or abbreviations) and exactly as per passport.

Booking conditions – Deposit payments made will be held until the number of participants for each safari vehicle is confirmed. If the safari must be cancelled, full refunds will be made, including the deposit. No refund can be made for pre-paid flights. Be sure your travel insurance covers this possibility.
