Non-refundable deposit of US \$1000 will hold your seat. (See booking conditions.) Full payment due July 21, 2026.

Price includes: transfers between airport and hotel in Nairobi - all accommodation, breakfasts, lunches (except 7) and dinners (except 2) – admissions as included in the itinerary – English speaking safari guides-drivers throughout – water in safari vehicles.

Price does not include: International flights – travel insurance (medical is mandatory) – tips of your choice – all other beverages.
